As former Committee Chair on Agriculture & Food Systems, I write in strong support of Agenda Item HCR 42—a House Concurrent Resolution encouraging each county in Hawai'i, including Maui, to establish its own biosecurity plan tailored to local needs

Invasive species continue to pose urgent threats: degrading native habitats, endangering endemic species, and jeopardizing agricultural livelihoods and public health. HCR 42 responds by encouraging localized biosecurity planning—empowering each county to develop proactive, community-based strategies for early detection, rapid response, and invasive species mitigation.

Maui County's leadership in adopting a customized biosecurity plan will strengthen statewide coordination, support innovative and culturally appropriate strategies, and safeguard Maui's unique ecosystems and agricultural resilience.
