BILLS TO AMEND THE KIHAI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AND WEST MAUI
COMMUNITY PLAN, AND TO CHANGE THE ZONING FOR CERTAIN TIMESHARE,
LEASEHOLD, AND OTHER PROPERTIES IN THE A-1 AND A-2 APARTMENT DISTRICTS**

The Maui Chamber of Commerce supports Resolution 26-110, referring bills to the Maui Planning Commission to amend the Kihei-Makena Community Plan and West Maui Community Plan and to change the zoning for certain timeshare, leasehold, and other properties in the A-1 and A-2 Apartment Districts.
